EVENT INFORMATION AND REGULATIONS

Dear Presidents, General Secretaries, Officials, Athletes, Coaches and Delegates of WDSF National Member Bodies,

Warm greetings from Chinese Taipei.

On behalf of the Chinese Taipei DanceSport Federation (CTDSF), we are pleased to invite all WDSF National Member Bodies to circulate this information to their athletes, coaches, officials and affiliated dance schools for participation in the 2026 WDSF Taipei Open.

The 2026 WDSF Taipei Open will be held on 1–2 August 2026 at Taipei Gymnasium, Taipei, Taiwan. The event will include WDSF Open events, CTDSF Open events, professional events, couple events, Solo events, Teacher & Student events, and the special Asian Solo Team Match.

The Asian Solo Team Match is not an officially approved WDSF or DSA event and does not carry WDSF ranking points. It is organized as a special invitational team event to promote exchange, visibility and friendly competition among Asian National Member Bodies.

2. Competition Events and Eligibility

Please refer to the official Event List for the complete list of events, provisional dates, dances, entry fees and eligibility requirements.

The Event List shall form an integral part of these Event Information and Regulations.

All eligibility requirements shall be based on the official Event List and the final regulations announced by the Organizing Committee.

The Organizing Committee reserves the right to combine, cancel, divide or adjust events according to the number of entries, competition conditions and operational requirements.

For WDSF events, athletes must hold valid WDSF MIN / WDSF ID where required under WDSF regulations.

For the Asian Solo Team Match, entries must be submitted by the respective WDSF National Member Body or its authorized representative. Direct individual registration may not be accepted unless otherwise announced by the Organizing Committee.

3. Registration

Registration Opens: 30 June 2026

Registration Deadline: 15 July 2026

All entries must be submitted through the official registration system or by the method announced by the Organizing Committee.

The Organizing Committee reserves the right to request proof of identity, age, WDSF MIN or other documents required for specific event eligibility where necessary.

4. Entry Fees, Payment and Cancellation

Entry fees shall be charged according to the official Event List and the official registration system.

The approximate EUR amounts shown in the Event List are for reference only. The final payable amount shall be based on the NTD amount announced by the Organizing Committee.

Payment Method: Online credit card payment through the official registration system.

A registration will only be considered completed after successful payment. If payment is not completed successfully, the registration will not be confirmed.

If the payment process is interrupted or unsuccessful, the system may not allow a new registration to be submitted immediately. In such cases, please contact the Organizing Committee for assistance in clearing the incomplete record and restarting the registration process.

Any bank charges, credit card charges, exchange rate differences or transaction fees shall be borne by the participant.

Cancellation Deadline: 15 July 2026.

Participants who cancel their registration after 15 July 2026, or fail to appear at the competition, will

not be eligible for any refund.

The Asian Solo Team Match is free of entry fee.

5. Schedule and Competition Procedure

The provisional competition dates and dances for each event are listed in the official Event List.

The final timetable, including registration, number collection, call room schedule, competition rounds, opening ceremony and award presentation, will be announced through official channels after the close of registration.

Athletes must report to the call room or preparation area according to the timetable announced by the Organizing Committee.

Athletes are responsible for checking the latest schedule, heat lists, call room announcements and competition progress.

Failure to appear after the official call may result in the athlete or couple being recorded as “No Show” or “Excuse”.

The Organizing Committee reserves the right to refuse entry, remove any person from the venue, or revoke access credentials in the event of violation of venue rules or competition regulations.

6. Accommodation, Transportation, Visa and Insurance

All overseas athletes, coaches, officials and accompanying persons shall arrange and cover their own travel, accommodation, meals, insurance, local transportation and other personal expenses.

The Organizing Committee may publish recommended hotel information, booking links, local transportation suggestions or other relevant local information through official channels. All bookings, payments, cancellations and related arrangements shall be made by the participants themselves.

The Organizing Committee does not guarantee hotel availability, room rates, airport transfers, taxi services, private transportation or any third-party service.

Participants who require an invitation letter for visa or entry purposes may submit a request to the Organizing Committee by 15 July 2026. The Organizing Committee may issue an invitation letter or event confirmation letter upon request; however, it does not guarantee the approval of any visa or entry permit.

All overseas participants are strongly advised to arrange appropriate travel insurance, medical insurance and personal accident insurance before traveling to Taiwan.

7. Dress Regulations

All competitors shall comply with the applicable WDSF Dress Regulations and/or CTDSF dress rules.

Additional restrictions may apply according to the Event List and applicable regulations.

The Chairperson and Organizing Committee may request any athlete to adjust or change attire if the attire is considered inconsistent with the applicable regulations.

8. Team Leader, Coach and Team Manager Passes

Each WDSF National Member Body participating in the 2026 WDSF Taipei Open will be issued one Team Leader Pass and one Coach Pass.

Overseas delegations with ten or more registered athletes may request one additional Team Manager Pass, subject to approval by the Organizing Committee.

All passes must be requested through the respective National Member Body or its authorized representative before the deadline announced by the Organizing Committee.

These passes are intended for delegation coordination and competition-related access only. They are not equivalent to audience tickets, VIP seats or unrestricted access passes.

The Organizing Committee reserves the right to approve, reject or revoke any accreditation pass.

9. Media Rights and Liability

By registering for the 2026 WDSF Taipei Open, all participants agree that the Organizing Committee may use their name, image, likeness, competition photos, videos, results and related materials for event promotion, media coverage, livestreaming, broadcasting, archival, educational and non-commercial promotional purposes.

All official livestreaming, broadcasting, photography, videography and commercial media rights shall belong to the Organizing Committee and/or its authorized partners.

Commercial photography, professional filming, livestreaming or media production inside the venue may require prior approval from the Organizing Committee.

All participants shall be responsible for their own health, safety, travel arrangements, personal belongings and insurance.

The Organizing Committee shall not be liable for any personal injury, illness, accident, loss, theft, damage, travel delay, visa issue, accommodation issue or other personal expense incurred in connection with participation in the event, except where required by applicable law.

10. Official Updates and Contact

All official updates, including registration, final schedule, adjudicator panels, coach passes, ticketing, call room arrangements, livestream information and regulations, will be published through the official channels of the Organizing Committee.

Participants are responsible for checking the latest announcements before and during the competition.

In the event of any discrepancy between earlier information and the latest official announcement, the latest official announcement shall prevail.
